



1. Introduction

1.1 Principles

1.1.1. Employers are responsible for the health, safety and welfare at work of all their workers. These responsibilities cannot be transferred to any other person, including those people who work alone. Workers have responsibilities to take reasonable care of themselves and other people affected by their work activities and to co-operate with their employers in meeting their legal obligations.

1.2 At the Centre

1.2.1. Staff and volunteers at Wildside Activity Centre should avoid working alone wherever possible. The site is somewhat isolated with some obvious physical risks such as the canal. In addition, the Centre is open to unplanned visits by members of the public.

1.3. Safeguarding

1.3.1. All staff and volunteers should be familiar with the Centre's Safeguarding Policy for children and vulnerable adults. They should always bear safeguarding concerns in mind, especially where a situation could be misconstrued.
